PLEASE READ THIS SHOW INFORMATION CAREFULLY .

WPDGA shows are sponsored in conjunction with the PDGA Big Weekend . In order to eliminate any confusion or mis-information, we suggest you read the show information carefully. This flyer pertains to the WPDGA shows only. An entry form for WPDGA shows is attached. If you wish to pre-enter any WPDGA show, this entry form must be used. By completing and sending the attached entry form, you will only be entered in the WPDGA shows for the weekend. Please use the entry form in the PDGA flyer to enter that show.

DIRECTIONS

The WPDGA Show will be held at the Centre County Fairgrounds in Centre Hall, PA. Centre Hall is located approximately 12 miles from State College, PA on Route 144. The fairgrounds are located in the center of town. Watch for Grange Fair and Goat Show entrance signs. Use Gates 2 and 3.

PENS

Pens will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Pen fees are \$1.00 each or a flat fee of \$5.00 for showing out of your trailer. Each pen used by exhibitor, for whatever purpose will be charged the pen fee. Please be considerate when using pens space to allow the maximum usage of barns. *Pen fees are payable to PDGA at check in or with your entry to PDGA. WPDGA will accept no pen fees.*
Hay or straw will not be available.

CAMPING

No fee will be charged for camping. There will be no camping permitted in the barns. Sleeping areas are permitted, however, no electrical appliances, other than those used for the direct care of the goats will be permitted. No alterations may be made to stalls, including removal of doors. A \$1.00 fee per stall used applies.

FOOD

A food stand will be available beginning Friday evening provided by the CCE group.

DOGS

Dogs must be restrained and are not permitted in the goat barns or show ring area.

BICYCLES, ETC.

No bicycles, scooters, roller blades or skate boards are permitted in or around the barns or show ring area.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These shows are sanctioned by ADGA and their rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned. The Judge's decision will be final.

The Show Committee, at it's discretion, may change the show order under circumstances as is necessary to assure the continuity of the show and the safety of it's exhibitors.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION

Base date of animals is to be the day the animal is shown. The original registration certificate is required for all animals over six (6) months of age. Animals under six (6) months must have stamped duplicate application, stamped duplicate Fax or registration certificate. All papers must be shown to the Show Secretary prior to show. No copies, telephone calls, or telegrams will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Current health papers must accompany animals originating from your home state. All animals must be listed on an official AAI-13 Health Certificate. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. DO NOT UNLOAD UNTIL ANIMALS HAVE BEEN CHECKED BY A DESIGNATED MEMBER OF THE WPDGA or PDGA SHOW COMMITTEE OR SHOW VETERINARIANS.** Any animals showing signs of infectious or contagious disease will be barred

from the show. No natural horned animals will be shown. The decision of the Show Committee and Show Veterinarian will be final. All animals checked in prior to the day of the show will be subject to these health regulations.

There will be no pre-show milk out but over uddering is not recommended.

CHECK IN

Animals may be checked in Friday, June 17, 2010 beginning at 5:00 PM until 15 minutes before the beginning of the show.

ENTRY FEES

- Junior and Senior Doe entry fees will be \$ 4.50 for one ring, \$ 7.50 for two rings, with a \$0.50 discount for PDGA & WPDGA members
- Pre-entries will be accepted beginning June 1, 2011 and will close June 14, 2011. Send pre-entries and fees to Show Secretary, Joseph B. Smith, 126 Big Foot Road, Dilliner, PA 15327. Make checks payable to WPDGA. Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00. No entry fees will be refunded for any reason.
- **No entries will be accepted after the class is called.**

Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Such conduct may result in disbarment from WPDGA shows.

Paid entry indicates acceptance of all show rules and regulations. The Show Committee reserves the right to interpret any show rule not adequately covered by these or ADGA rules.

WPDGA will not be responsible for any accidents or loss to persons, property or animals while on the grounds.
